

Tamir is staff lawyer with the Samuelson-Glushko Canadian Internet Policy & Public Interest Clinic (CIPPIC) at the University of Ottawa's Centre for Law, Technology & Society, where he leads CIPPIC's privacy, net neutrality, electronic surveillance, telecommunications regulation and cybersecurity activities.
